

## 'Metal' skin

Like the look of metal? On doors, countertops or even entire walls? There's a new porcelain panel product designed to skin large surfaces with a metallic-looking finish. It's called Oxide and it comes in seven colors ranging from light to dark, with metallic effects that look like they've been weathered by natural elements.

The large-scale panels (1 by 3 meters, or approximately 3 by 9 feet) are manufactured by Tennessee-based Laminam by Crossville. They'll be available locally, starting late this month, from Kate-Lo Tile & Stone, with locations in Plymouth, Burnsville and Oakdale.

[RepairClinic.com](http://RepairClinic.com), an online store for replacement parts for appliances and outdoor power equipment, recently enhanced its free Repair Help feature to help DIYers fix common problems associated with major home appliances and outdoor power equipment.
